### Aims of the group

The chief aims and activities of the group shall be in consultation with and with the approval of, the London Borough of Croydon on behalf of the National Trust.

- 1) To ensure that Selsdon Wood is maintained:
  - a) for the benefit of the flora and fauna so that no one species shall threaten the survival of another and;
  - b) for the enjoyment and well being of the public
- 2) To carry out programmes of practical work, especially sustainable conservation and restoration work.
- 3) To educate volunteers of all ages in the principles and practices of nature conservation and encourage the public interest in Selsdon Wood.
- 4) To act as a forum for discussion on issues that may affect the aims and activities.
- 5) To raise money as necessary for the carrying out of its work.

The area served shall be Selsdon Wood as contained within the boundaries controlled by the London Borough of Croydon on behalf of the National Trust.
