Last Month's Work Session - Sunday 2nd July – The Butterfly Bank fence is in need of repair and we made a start on this job by replacing several stakes and strimming some of the long grass on the top side of the bank. More work will be done on this at a later date. We cleared encroaching vegetation around several seats in Great Field & David's Crook and cut down one large Laurel. Laurel is an invasive species, and we try to keep it under control in our wood. The cut Laurel branches were placed on top of old dead branches to prevent them touching the ground where they could reroot. Finally, two fallen trees were cleared from blocked paths.

<u>Linden Glade Pool Project</u> – The repair and refurbishment of the pool in Linden Glade is an ongoing project which will, we hope, be completed in the next month or two. The pool has been leaking badly for a few years now and we plan to reline it with fiberglass, erect a fence around it to keep out people and dogs and then refill it. The surrounding area will be landscaped, and the pool planted with vegetation to encourage rich biodiversity. Last Month's Butterfly Walk - Saturday July 9th — In less than favourable conditions, and with a threat of thundery showers, Daniel Bound led a group of 18 on the Butterfly Walk. The Butterfly Bank was a disappointment but elsewhere in Field 1 we saw Meadow Brown, Large White, Marbled White and Small Skipper. Crossing the corner of Field 2 we entered David's Crook where we found more Marbled Whites and added Large Skipper and Gatekeeper. Via Pool Grove and Linden Glade we followed West Gorse and saw many Ringlets which were the most numerous species seen during the walk. In The Wend there was another Meadow Brown, a definite Essex Skipper and more Ringlets. On the route back to the car park we saw a Red Admiral in Great Field. In three places during the walk we felt raindrops but nothing developed until after the walk when quite heavy rain fell. Many thanks to Daniel Bound for leading the walk ©


