

Three Dandelion type flowers to spot this month. All are widespread in our fields.

Hawkweed



Goatsbeard



Catsear



This has a cluster of flowers at the top of each stem. Individual flowers are smaller than those of Goatsbeard or Catsear. The seed heads also form a cluster



A single flower at the top of each stem surrounded by long green bracts. The flowers only open fully on sunny mornings so a folk name for the plant is Jack-go-to-bed-at-noon.



A single flower at the top of each stem but possibly some side branches lower down. No long bracts. The leaves at the base form a rosette similar to that of a Dandelion.
