

Birds - species seen (or heard - h) in Selsdon Wood

The following bird list was originally based on Ted Forsyth's regular observations over many years, with additions from David Malins. This information is given in the Notes and Sightings column. **Red text** shows a bird sighted for the first time this year or rare species not sighted for many years previously.

Species recorded between 1972 & 1977 in the Penry-Jones booklet* are noted by a Y in the 1978 column. Photographs on our website are indicated by a Y in the Photo column. Sightings in 2020 and thereafter are first recorded sightings/photographs (or hearings - marked with H) of the year supplied mainly by FSW members and members of the FSW Facebook group. Birds are listed in alphabetical order, although some are grouped in families.

2023 Marks birds heard on the 6th May Dawn Chorus Walk. This includes a Cuckoo which has not been heard in our wood for almost a decade.
