Last Month's Walks - Butterflies, Bats & Moths - We had two walks in July looking at Lepidoptera. The butterfly walk on 13th was attended by 12 people who spotted 6 species of butterfly and one day-flying moth. On the Bat & Moth walk on the evening of 18th Tony & Ted dealt with the moth trap while Steve Budd led 24 visitors around the fields and woodlands to seek for bats. He told us all about the recording equipment he has which detects different species and one walker reported that the electronic devices coming to life every time a bat came close was an exciting almost eerie experience. Pipistrelle bats were detected though unfortunately none of the other 7 species that have been observed in the wood this year.
