Feeding the Birds in Selsdon Wood – Please do not put out bread or foods like raisins for the birds. These are not good for the birds & poisonous to other woodland species such as foxes and to dogs.

We have a bird feeding station so if you would like to feed the birds, please contribute some money to FSW funds to pay for the regular top-ups there. Thank you.

Wood Carvings Project – At the Committee Meeting on 31st March 2025 it was agreed that we would commission a more local wood sculptor, Lorcan O'Byrne, to make a new carving. We had already walked around the wood with him, and he had chosen 3 possible sites and sent sketches of the possible carvings. We asked him to start by carving a badger for us on an Ash stump in Steven's Walk for a price of £500.

Steve accompanied him to make a video of the carving and to keep walkers away from the work in progress. This Badger was completed in 2 days on 7th and 8th April.

After confirming that we had no objections, Lorcan attached this small plaque to the foot of the carving showing his contact details. FSW will soon be adding a similar small plaque to all the carvings to remind admirers that they all are fully funded by the Friends. Please donate to us directly or via Just Giving so that we can afford another piece of his work.

April Work Sessions – Sadly the first job of the month was the cleaning of graffiti from the notice board at the Yew Tree Way entrance. Many thanks to John who removed it on 1st April. There were not many tree falls but a couple were cleared later in the month.

On the April Work Sessions, we tidied the store and fitted a new shelving unit. We topped up the water in the Jubilee Pond and watered & weeded on the butterfly bank and around the Marjoram planted last year in David's Crook. We also trimmed back the car park edging on the entrance slope to improve access for pushchair and wheelchairs and sprayed all the wood carvings with a preservative solution.
